Public Question Time

A member of the public raised concerns about an annex built in the rear of a property, that contravenes the planning permission that had previously been approved (P23/03509/Full, 68 Court Road, Kingswood). He was supported by three other members of the public with the same concerns, and wanted the council to be aware of these concerns when considering this planning application.

Whilst the new application is for retrospective permission, the resident informed the council about the annex, that was significantly larger than what had been originally approved, and that the property was not appropriate for its location, it was not finished to the approved specification and had been built with additional features. Further issues were raised about the size of the building, the changes to the fence line, the limited gap between properties, and the changes to carparking, as well as concern that the annex might be used as a separate dwelling.

Presentation from the Community Connection Team, South Gloucestershire Council

Councillors received a presentation about the need to improve connecting habitats, as part of the nature recovery network, in order to prevent the loss or decline in certain species. They explained how local areas can make a big impact, from improving school playgrounds and sports pitches to railway paths, grass verges and waterways. Through the planting of trees and pollinators, to reducing the frequency of grass cutting, lots could be done at community level to improve the biodiversity of the local area. Kingswood Town Council was asked if it would consider giving its support to the scheme by encouraging any volunteering opportunities and supporting a future nature reserve launch. The Council was in support of the scheme and would promote it through social media and via its connections with other community groups.

After a discussion on the size of the new annex, which appeared to be an overdevelopment for the site, concern that the property might be used as a separate dwelling, and the unfair and unreasonable impact of the significantly larger property on the neighbouring properties, the council agreed unanimously to object to this planning application, and to request that the property reverts to the specification agreed in the previous planning application.

Councillor Rhodes presented the budget report to the council, asking members to support a budget and precept for 2024/25 of £826,480. Councillors were satisfied that they had given several proposals scrutiny over the last two meetings, reducing it in size, and being mindful of the impact on residents.

The council wanted to be dynamic and make an impact on the lives of residents of Kingswood, and having spoken with residents, it wants to provide groundbreaking and exciting opportunities for the Young People. In addition, it wants to create a sense of pride and community involvement by offering a range of activities and events to all ages of the community with the provision of a budget that supports an events programme. A community grants scheme will ensure that the local groups, that have been subject to financial pressures and cutbacks, might thrive and be able to offer a great deal of support to the local community, and the council's aspiration to one day own a building that creates a hub to bring residents together.

The budget was proposed by Councillor Rhodes, seconded by Councillor Corrigan with all councillors in support.

Resolved: to agree to the budget and precept of £826,480 and delegate authority to the Town Clerk to make the request of South Gloucestershire Council.
