### Questions and comments from members of the public (Fifteen Minute)

This provides an opportunity for members of the public (who are not usually permitted to speak during the meeting except by special invitation of the Chair) to participate before the start of the meeting by asking questions, raising concerns or making comments on matters affecting Kingswood. No decision can be taken during this session, but the Chairman may decide to refer any matters raised for further consideration.

No prior notification is needed but it would be helpful to let the office know of any plans to film or record so that any necessary arrangements can be made to provide reasonable facilities to report on meetings. This permission does not extend to private meetings or parts of meetings which are not open to the public. All recording and photography equipment should be taken away if a public meeting moves into a session which is not open to the public. If you are recording the meeting, you are asked to act in a reasonable manner and not disrupt the conduct of meetings for example by using intrusive lighting, flash photography or asking people to repeat statements for the benefit of the recording. You may not make an oral commentary during the meeting. The Chair has the power to control public recording and/or reporting so it does not disrupt the meeting. Recording must be clearly visible to anyone at the meeting.

Erection of 1no detached dwelling with access and associated works.

   Demolition of existing storage building. Erection of detached dwelling with new access and associated works.
- c. Reference: P23/03368/O. Land At Former Lucas Works Moravian Road Kingswood Bristol South Gloucestershire
  Outline permission for demolition of existing buildings and redevelopment of the site for a mixed use scheme comprising up to 140 dwellings, 1650sqm of commercial space (Use Class E), creation of new access into the site and associated works with access to be determined all other matters reserved.

Works to 1no. Copper Beech to Crown lift to up to 6m, to crown reduce eastern side of crown by up to 2m over neighbouring property and to crown thin by 15%. Works to 1no. Copper Beech to crown lift up tp 6m, cut back from utility lines to provide a 1m clearance and crown thin by up to 15%. Both trees covered by Tree Preservation Order KTPO 12/91 dated 23<sup>rd</sup> March 1992.

e. **Reference**; **P24/01365/HH.** 53 South Road Kingswood South Gloucestershire BS15 8JQ

Erection of a side and rear roof extension with rear dormer to facilitate loft conversion.

5. **To note the appeal P24/00461/F:** Land To The Rear Of 46 High Street Kingswood South Gloucestershire BS15 4AJ Demolition of existing outbuilding and erection of 1no. dwelling with associated amenity space, refuse/recycling and cycle storage.

An appeal has been made to the Secretary of State against the decision of South Gloucestershire Council. The appeal is against the refusal of planning permission. The appeal will be determined on the basis of **written representations**. The procedure to be followed is set out in Part 2 of the Town and Country Planning (Appeals) (Written Representations Procedure) (England) Regulations 2009 as amended.

KTC considered this application on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2024 and had no objections.
