General Update

Issues Raised last month

Park Road – The team have received intelligence that drug dealing is taking place in the street on Park Road. The team have conducted high visibility patrols in the area, to detect and deter this issue, as well as gather further information and intelligence to assist with solving this problem. No suspicious activity has been witnessed. We will continue to patrol the area and monitor reports.

Douglas Road – The team are aware of some concerning incident over the last 6 months on Douglas Road, including reports of someone with a machete, anti-social behaviour and drug dealing intelligence. This team have conducted high visibility patrols in the area, to detect and deter this issue, as well as gather further information and intelligence to assist with solving this problem. No suspicious activity has been witnessed. We will continue to patrol the area and monitor reports.

Issues Raised this month

Castle Road/Soundwell Road – The team have received recent intelligence that drug dealing is taking place in the lane/walkway between Castle Road and Soundwell Road. We plan to conduct high visibility patrols in the area, particularly on later shifts, to detect and deter this issue, as well as gather further information and intelligence to assist with solving this problem.

Community Engagement

The PCSO's on the team have conducted a successful beat surgery in Kings Chase Shopping Centre, which was a positive opportunity to speak with the public and any concerns they had about issues in the local area.

We also plan on meeting the members of a new community group due to be open on Moravian Road in the not-too-distant future.

Business Engagement

Regent Street and Kings Chase Shopping Centre have the most footfall on the beat. The PCSO's conduct regular targeted patrols in the area to deter crime and ASB, as well as amazing opportunities to meet members of the local community.

This month has been a vastly different time for the team. As a result of the violent disorder taking place all over the country, the team have been placed on 12 hour shifts and been supporting operations across the force relating to this.
