



COMMUNITY GRANT SCHEME 2024 TO 2025

Summary of Grants Awarded

Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Primary School was awarded a grant of £1,250 towards the creation of a sensory play and learning area in the school grounds, to improve opportunities to connect with outdoors creative play. [Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Primary School: Welcome](#)

Whitfield Tabernacle was awarded a grant of 2,500 for external signage to provide an identity to the building. They also received a grant of £2,500 as a contribution to insurance and repairs. [The Tabernacle Kingswood](#)

Kingswood Heritage Museum Trust was awarded a grant of £10,000 as a contribution towards the cost of solar panels and batteries that will reduce the carbon footprint and lead to overhead savings, thus putting more funds into the community benefit of the museum. [The Museum - Kingswood Museum](#)

We are BS15 was awarded £4,980 as a contribution to support 3 interconnected projects addressing essential community needs in Kingswood to create a hub for residents to access diverse support programmes, that includes a community kitchen and food club, as well as community allotment and social café. South Gloucestershire Youth Housing was awarded £1,039 as a contribution to buy replacement furniture for the hostel to ensure health and safety and comfort for residents. The grant would be to purchase equipment and furniture for 2 rooms. [SGYH](#)

Kingswood Rugby Club was awarded £5,000 as a contribution towards the costs of a concrete path around the newly built changing and storage facility to assure safe accessibility for all users especially those with mobility issues. [Kingswood RFC](#)

Friends of Holy Trinity Church were awarded £387.16 as a contribution towards equipment to manage the graves and areas within the closed churchyard that will showcase the history of Kingswood as well as increase the biodiversity in the churchyard and create a place for quiet reflection. The Brightwell was awarded £600 as a contribution towards funding the cost of providing subsidised oxygen therapy for members in Kingswood who live with the effects of neurological conditions. The charity provides therapies and services available to all residents of Kingswood that are not available elsewhere. The Brightwell fills a gap in provision for people in Kingswood living with neurological conditions and seeks to close the health inequality gap so that people from Kingswood can remain as healthy and as active as possible for as long as possible.
